

The One-Year MBA

The One-Year MBA is designed to enable highly motivated and highly qualified students to complete the Master of Business Administration in the General Management Track in 12 months.

Admission Process. Students complete the online admissions application for the MBA program at www.stmarytx.edu/grad.

- Attain a minimum GMAT score of 525.
- Earn an undergraduate degree in business from an accredited institution
- Earn an acceptable GPA on all previous course work completed.
- Submit two (2) copies of official transcripts from all previous schools attended.
- Submit a resume and two letters of reference

International Student Admission Requirements. In addition to those listed above, international students must meet the following requirements:

- Provide evidence of English-language proficiency by achieving a minimum TOEFL score of 570 (paper), 230 (computer) or 67 (Internet) [87 including speaking]. A minimum score of 6.5 on the IELTS English-language proficiency test (Academic or General) also will be accepted.
- Degrees granted by non-U.S. institutions are reviewed to determine equivalency with a U.S. undergraduate degree. In some cases, students may be required to complete an additional year of study to achieve equivalency.

Greehey Scholarship Requirements. Students admitted to the One-Year MBA program are eligible for consideration to receive a Greehey Scholarship. This scholarship covers all tuition, fees and books for the 12 months of the one-year program. To be considered for Greehey Scholarship standing, interested students must

- Attain a minimum GMAT score of 550.
- Have previously satisfied all prerequisite knowledge requirements.
- Earn a minimum 3.25 GPA on all undergraduate work.
- Submit required essays.
- Complete an interview process.
- Agree to accept the scholarship and serve as a graduate research assistant during the term of the scholarship.
- **International students** must earn a minimum TOEFL score of 71 (Internet) [93 including speaking], 240 (computer) or 587 (paper). A minimum score of 7.0 on the IELTS English-language proficiency test (Academic or General) also will be accepted.

Prerequisite Knowledge Requirements. To be admitted to the One-Year MBA, students must first satisfy the MBA program's prerequisite knowledge requirements in micro and macro-economics, managerial and financial accounting, marketing, finance, information systems and statistics by

- Earning an undergraduate degree in business from an accredited institution.
- A minimum grade of C is required for all courses used to satisfy prerequisite knowledge requirements.
- Remaining prerequisite knowledge requirements can be satisfied by completing the related

undergraduate course or by successfully completed the related CLEP or DANTES proficiency examination.

Student Course Load & Schedule. Students enrolled in the One-Year MBA program take 12 hours each fall and spring semester and then complete an additional six hours, including the MBA capstone course during the summer. The following schedule illustrates a typical course load in the One-Year MBA program.
