FINANCIAL AID AT ST. MARY'S UNIVERSITY

Students interested in applying for additional need-based financial assistance must submit the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** each year to determine eligibility for institutional, state or federal need-based grant and/or loan programs.

The FAFSA is available beginning October 2016 for the 2017-18 academic year and should be submitted with you and your family's 2015 income tax information.
